

LIC Janaza Policy

Lewisham Islamic Centre provides Janaza service to the Muslim community.

LIC must be informed at the soonest time by the family members of the deceased if they want to use LIC's Janaza service, so that preparation can be made early and to avoid any unnecessary delays.

Prior to the Janaza Service, a Janaza application form must be filled up by a family member of the deceased person. And a copy of death certificate must be attached.

The reason for death must be stated on the application form.

The Imam of LIC reserves the right to withdraw any application form if it does not meet up with LIC's requirements.

Non-Muslim family and friends can attend the ceremony, however they will not be able to take part in the Janaza prayer, they will be provided with a seating area where they can wait. They must also abide by the visitors policy (Please see LIC's visitors policy).

Lewisham Islamic Centre will not allow any practices outside the fold of Islam (from authentic Qur'an and Sunnah) to take place during the ceremony and within the LIC premises. Lewisham Islamic Centre reserves the right to intervene should anything out the fold of Islam take place.
